THE GONDWANA CARE TRUST SUPPORTS THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS ACROSS NAMIBIA:

WINDHOEK, OKAHANDJA, REHOBOTH – GONDWANA TRAVEL CENTRE

Dagbreek School:

This public school welcomes children with special needs. Gondwana also welcomes a group of learners free of charge at their lodges, every year.

MEGS

provides support and food hampers to the most disadvantaged in Windhoek, Katutura.

The **Rainbow Nation Soup Kitchen** in Rehoboth.

The “Heal the Land”

Okahandja Soup Kitchen and MEGS feed the most disadvantaged in Okahandja.

The **Rehoboth Food for Life Kitchen** provides a meal to the elderly twice a week.

The Mammadu Trust provides education, homework support as well as three meals a day to Katutura disadvantaged children.

MARIENTAL, STAMPRIET – KALAHARI ANIB LODGE & KALAHARI FARMHOUSE WITH SSC

The **Soetdoringlaagte Crèche**

takes care of underprivileged children and provides them with a pre-school education.

The Marinata Project

helps feeding the elderly.

The **Wisdom Youth Organisation**

in Stampriet is a multi-purpose centre and provides basic education and homework support to more than 60 kids and provides a meal once a day to the children.



KEETMANSHOOP – CANYON LODGE, VILLAGE & ROADHOUSE

The **Don Bosco Primary School** in Keetmanshoop and the **Geduld Primary School** in Grünau accommodate young learners in need of charitable donations.

SWAKOPMUND / WALVIS BAY – THE DELIGHT SWAKOPMUND

Mwadinomo Pre-School & Day Care Centre:

This crèche allows children to learn the basics before going to grade 1 and provides them with a meal. They are safe while the parents are at work.

JJs Care Centre

accommodates children with special needs. The centre is the only one on the coast to teach sign language and maintains a small hostel.
